Admissions

Admission requirements

- An undergraduate degree from a recognized university with at least a B average (3.0 GPA) or equivalent in the final 60 credit hours taken at a university.
- If your first language is not English, you must submit an official TOEFL iBT® or IELTS. Tests cannot be more than two years old. We require an overall IELTS score of 7.0 with no band below 6.5.
- You must provide a current CV and supplementary documents including references.
- You must be available for a timed, online interview.

Studying in Canada

As an international student, you may be required to obtain a study permit issued by the Canadian government's Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) department prior to beginning your studies. You may apply once you receive your official letter of acceptance from Saint Mary's University. We recommend applying early for your permit as processing times can vary.

Studying in Canada as an international student offers numerous potential benefits, including the opportunity to work while studying, obtaining a post-graduate work permit, and exploring immigration programs and pathways. Students are granted these allowances through IRCC, and more information can be found at canada.ca/studyincanada.

Program details

A key strength of the MTEI program lies in the expertise of our respected faculty and our close ties with industry. Our small class sizes mean students reap the benefits of these close interactions, gaining knowledge from faculty, industry mentors and fellow students.

You can complete a Master of Technology Entrepreneurship & Innovation degree in just 16 months. Attend classes on Fridays and Saturdays of each week over eight months, then choose one of four options to complete your degree: work with a team to launch a startup, gain practical skills and knowledge from an internship, develop a thesis, or complete further course work to add to your learnings.

Startup Stream

Complete your degree in as little as a year to 16 months when you choose to launch a new business with the MTEI incubator, Catalyst.

Thesis Stream

Under the supervision of an approved faculty member, identify a technology or business-related problem and write a thesis in an area of technological entrepreneurship or innovation.

Gain and refine valuable research skills with this option and even prepare yourself for the pursuit of a PhD.

Internship Stream

Students are chosen by suitability for internship and GPA throughout the program. If selected for an internship during your program, you could enter the industry within eight months of starting the MTEI program and spend another six months as an intern.

Coursework Stream

Take four additional courses in entrepreneurship and other business disciplines to supplement your learning.
